Transfer tickets are issued when a fare is paid (cash), are valid on any Petaluma Transit bus for 2 hours in any direction of travel, and are non-transferable. Quarterly Youth Passes are available online and/or at the schools listed below. Youth registered for the discounted/free lunch program may qualify for a discounted quarterly youth pass at the schools listed below. You may also use a Youth Clipper Card and it is available online or at our offices.

#### Where to Get a Schedule

Petaluma Transit schedules are available at City Hall, the Community Center, the Public Library, and at various locations throughout Petaluma. All buses carry our schedules, or you can call us at 707-778-4460 and we would be glad to mail you a copy.

#### **Bus Stops**

Buses stop at designated Petaluma Transit stops, generally every few blocks along the route. Bus stop location information can be obtained by calling 707-778-4460, visiting our website, or in the most current Rider Guide.

#### **Be Early**

Always get to your bus stop five minutes before your bus is scheduled to arrive. We will do our best, but variations in weather and traffic conditions sometimes make it impossible to operate exactly on the scheduled times.

#### **Passengers in Wheelchairs**

All of our routes are accessible to wheelchair passengers. We ask that all wheelchairs have a working brake system.

#### **Bicycles on Buses**

Petaluma Transit buses are equipped with front-mounted bicycle racks. These racks can accommodate two to three bicycles very quickly and easily. Riders are responsible for loading and unloading bicycles on first-come, first-served basis.

#### **Rules for Safe Riders**

- Please do not distract the driver while he or she is driving the bus.
- Please stand behind the white line.
- All animals must ride in carriers, except service animals.

#### It's Against State Law To:

- Evade payment of bus fare, or misuse transfers, passes or tickets to avoid fare payment.
- Play radios, stereos or other sound equipment when riding a bus.
- Smoke, eat, drink or expectorate while on the bus.
- Willfully disturb other bus riders through boisterous or unruly behavior.
- Penal Code Section 640 makes these infractions punishable by a fine of up to \$250.00











